- Holds and drinks from a cup with minimal spilling
- · Able to fill spoon and bring to mouth with little spillage
- Gives up bottle
- Unzips zippers and unbuttons large buttons
- Requires assistance to pull clothes over head
- · Able to take off pants, coat, socks, and shoes without fasteners
- Has few accidents during day and indicates when needs to go to bathroom
- · Independent at dressing
- · Might need some help with fasteners
- · Able to bathe self with exception of own hair
- · Independent with toilet and notifications
- Buttons and unbuttons independently
- Pours liquid from cup with minimal spills
- Mashes food with utensils
- May use a knife to cut food
- Can use toilet on own
- Use fork and spoon Independent with shoe tying
- Only requires supervision for bath time
